

How to buy BBO\$

As you register to BBO, the program generates automatically a "BBO\$ account" linked only to the chosen nick.

Depending upon the interface you are using this are the some steps:

Using the new interface:

- 1) From Lobby click "**Our Online Store**"
- 2) Click "**Buy BB\$ -- used for ACBL entry fees, renting robots, etc.**"
- 3) Click "**Purchase BB\$ with a credit card or paypal**"

Using the old interface:

- 1) From Lobby click "**Shop Bridge – Buy Bridge Products**"
- 2) Click "**Purchase BB\$ with a credit card or paypal**"

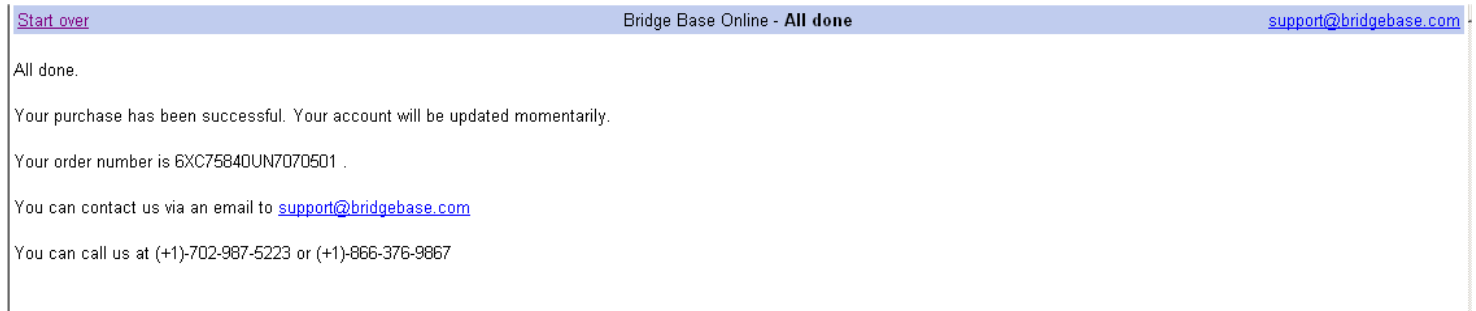
In both cases you'll see on your screen the following screenshot:

If you have a Paypal account follow the instructions that appear on the right box. Digit all the the credit card details you are using **choosing the amount in USD you want to charge on your BBO\$** account and click on "Purchase" button. A "confirmation screenshot" like this will be displayed on your screen:



All transactions on BBO are carried out using a Secure Server, Very Sign certified.

When you will reconnect to BBO a special "pop up message" will appear, informing you about the succeeded transaction and showing the new balance of your BBO\$ account.

Note that every time you login on BBO the first message you receive will display your BBO\$ Account Balance.
